TELL CONGRESS: VOTE "NO" ON THE PERMIT ACT

We're calling H.R. 3898 the "Permission to Pollute" Act because it weakens Clean Water Act protections.

WHAT THE BILL DOES:



Removes safeguards for streams, wetlands, and seasonal waters

Less Protection



Includes cost to polluters as a factor for pollution standards, instead of solely relying on science

Anti-Science



Lets water polluters off the hook if they do not report toxic discharges

Gift to Polluters



Doubles how long an industrial wastewater pollution permit lasts — from 5 to 10 years

Less Oversight



Stops EPA from requiring new or innovative pollution control technology

Backward Thinking



Strips states and tribes of their power to block or require conditions for harmful federal projects

Less Power to States & Tribes



Authorizes sweeping "general" pollution permits with fewer safeguards
